# Floor Maintenance & Cleaning Specification Polysafe- Wetroom Floorcare Information



# **General Guidelines:**

Polysafe (Hydro • Hydro Evolve • Quattro) Wetroom Safety Vinyl Sheeting is manufactured with aggregates throughout the product to improve traction and safety underfoot. The product features a high quality cross-linked polyurethane reinforcement and **should not be sealed**.

**NOTE:** We highly recommend an effective barrier/entrance matting system to reduce the dirt tracked into the building.

#### **Daily Maintenance:**

- 1. Remove all dust, sand and stones from the floor using a vacuum cleaner.
- 2. Spot mop wet sticky dirt with a double/single bucket mopping unit using a **Vileda Safe Mop** and the correct dilution of neutral detergent such as **Proclean.**
- For larger areas, the floor can be washed using a Nilfisk Automatic Scrubber-Drier, Prolene Brush and Proslip low foam neutral detergent.
- 4. For kitchens, a food safe chemical such as **Diner-gen** degreaser should be used for mopping and/or scrubbing.

**Note:** Only a Prolene brush should be used to scrub the floor.

#### **Periodic Cleaning**

For high traffic or heavily soiled areas the floor can be deep cleaned periodically

- 1. Remove all dust, sand and stones from the floor using a vacuum cleaner.
- 2. Scrub the floor using a Low Speed Scrubber fitted with a Prolene Brush.
- 3. For light to medium soiling, a solution of **Proclean** neutral detergent can be used for scrubbing. For heavily soiled areas, **Proflex** diluted according to manufacturer's instructions can be used. For detail work, a hand brush with prolene bristles can be used.
- 4. Vacuum the dirty chemical solution from the floor with a Wet & Dry Vacuum Cleaner.
- 5. Rinse the floor thoroughly with clean water to remove any remaining chemical residue.
- 6. If no machine is available, remove the solution from the floor using a mop and mopping system. The water and mop must be changed frequently so as to remove as much of the chemical residue as possible.

**Note:** Only a Prolene brush should be used to scrub the floor. The floor must be thoroughly rinsed with clean water after stripping to neutralize the area.

# **Recommended Products:**



#### **Cleaning of Equipment:**

- 1. All equipment should be cleaned thoroughly after use.
- 2. Pads should be rinsed or vacuumed depending on soiling.
- 3. Single disc machines must be wiped with a damp cloth and disinfectant if needed.
