Floor Maintenance & Cleaning Specification

Polysafe Wetroom Safety Vinyl Flooring





General Guidelines:

Polysafe (Hydro • Hydro Evolve • Quattro) Safety Vinyl Flooring is manufactured with aggregates throughout the product to improve traction and safety underfoot. The product should not be sealed.

NOTE: We highly recommend an effective barrier/entrance matting system to reduce the dirt tracked into the building.

Daily Maintenance:

- 1. Remove all dust, sand and stones from the floor using a vacuum cleaner.
- 2. Spot mop wet sticky dirt with a double/single bucket mopping unit using a **Filmop Puli Scrub Mop*** and the correct dilution of neutral detergent such as **Proclean**.
- 3. For larger areas, the floor can be washed using a **Nilfisk Automatic Scrubber-Drier**, **Prolene Brush** and **Proslip** low foam neutral detergent.
- 4. For kitchens, a food safe chemical such as **Diner-gen degreaser** should be used for mopping and/or scrubbing.

^{*}The Puli-Scrub Mop has nylon inserts which allow it to glide easily over safety floors.



Periodic Cleaning

For high traffic or heavily soiled areas the floor can be deep cleaned periodically:

- 1. Remove all dust, sand and stones from the floor using a vacuum cleaner.
- 2. Scrub the floor using a Low Speed Scrubber fitted with a Prolene Brush.
- 3. For light to medium soiling, a solution of **Proclean** neutral detergent can be used for scrubbing. For heavily soiled areas, **Proflex** diluted according to manufacturer's instructions can be used. For detail work, a hand brush with prolene bristles can be used.
- 4. Vacuum the dirty chemical solution from the floor with a Wet & Dry Vacuum Cleaner.
- 5. Rinse the floor thoroughly with clean water to remove any remaining chemical residue.
- 6. If no machine is available, remove the solution from the floor using a mop and mopping system. The water and mop must be changed frequently so as to remove as much of the chemical residue as possible.

Note: Note: Only a Prolene brush should be used to scrub the floor. The floor must be thoroughly rinsed with clean water after scrubbing.

Cleaning of Equipment:

- 1. All equipment should be cleaned thoroughly after use.
- 2. Pads should be rinsed or vacuumed depending on soiling.
- 3. Single disc machines must be wiped with a damp cloth and disinfectant if needed.
